

## INTERACTIVE MERIDIAN TOOTH CHART INSTRUCTIONS

### Contents of the Installation Disk:

### General Description:

The Interactive Meridian Tooth Chart (IMTC) consists of an SWF file. The file is encrypted to prevent decompiling of the content.

Your website domain name is also coded into the file. The IMTC will not work on any other domain. If you are changing your domain name, contact American Bio-Compatible Health Systems, Inc. for a new file. The license is only valid for one domain at a time.

**Included on the disk you received is an EXE file, which will allow you to use the IMTC on your computer as an educational tool in your office.** This file should operate independently. If for some reason your computer asks for a program to open the file, it is best displayed in Adobe Flash Player.

Also included on the disk is the Adobe Flash Player 10 software, in the event you are attempting to view the IMTC on your website and you don't have a player currently installed.

### Web Site Installation:

1. The IMTC is simply an SWF file that may be inserted into any web page on your web site. The locking mechanism will allow its use on any web page within your domain.
2. It is important to upload the file to your server with your other web site files. It may reside in the root directory or in any folder on the server that is hosting your domain. When the file is inserted onto the page, be sure to have the file path point to the location on the server of the SWF file.
3. The dimensions of the chart are 680 pixels by 420 pixels. For optimal viewing, resizing is possible, but not recommended.

### Recommendations:

If you would like to be found in search engines for your tooth chart, put the words "Meridian Tooth Chart" in your title bar for that page.
